Te Matatini Herenga Waka Herenga Tangata National Kapa Haka Festival 2022

Te Matatini event organisers have made a decision on the future of the 2022 Te Matatini Herenga Waka Herenga Tangata National Kapa Haka Festival.

After much deliberation, specialist's advice from Māori health experts and statisticians relating to the current climate of COVID-19 in Aotearoa, Te Matatini has made the collective decision to **postpone** Te Matatini Herenga Waka Herenga Tangata National Kapa Haka Festival until **February 2023.**

The festival will remain at Eden Park (Ngā Ana Wai) in Tāmaki Makaurau and all qualifiers and judges will remain the same as they currently stand.

COVID-19 Protection Framework

On Friday 22 October 2021, the Prime Minister announced the new COVID-19 Protection Framework (CPF), that will come into effect when each DHB region has 90% full vaccination.

The CPF will eventually replace the Alert Level System.

- Green aims to allow almost normal social and economic activity while continuing to build health system capacity
- Orange aims to avoid exponential growth in cases with moderate population level controls, and
- Red aims to protect the sustainability of the health system and the health of communities through population-level controls.
