Mataora - Kaihaka hauora journey Marama Jones

Ngāi Te Rangi, Ngāti Ranginui, Ngāti Pūkenga

Marama Jones is a māmā to three beautiful tamariki and is a TV Producer for Pukana and Hakapedia.

Marama has performed with the 2019 reigning champions, Ngā Tumanako ever since she has left Kura. She says " the importance of maintaining a healthy lifestyle is critical to keeping up with the physically demanding aspects of kapa haka which any kaihaka could relate to".

Marama originally began her hauora journey to lose weight but over time her whakaaro shifted to maintaining a healthy lifestyle to be the best version of herself. Marama says " being physically fit has allowed me to execute performances a little easier but there is no other genre, sport, or workout routine that can prepare me for kapa haka because that requires you to move, run around, and sing continuously for 30-minutes straight all while trying to stay in-sync with 39 other performers". If scripts are received incompleted and pass the deadline, automatic penalty of 5 points will be deducted from your kapa haka.

Stage dimensions *

Te Matatini will be using the same stage as the last 4 Festivals which will be 22m x 17m maximum performance area.
